The Street Van

Street vans operating in metropolitan Perth and various regional centres in WA. Vans operate on Friday and Saturday nights are staffed by a youth worker and a team of trained volunteers. They provide information, informal counselling and referral advice to young people at risk and on the streets during these times.

Information

Street Vans carry a vast range of resources and information about drugs and alcohol, related issues and information about other support agencies who can assist. The street van team is also able to provide verbal information on a range of issues.

Support

Trained staff and volunteers aim to be a listening ear to clients and provide informal counselling on issues ranging from homelessness, family issues, drug and alcohol abuse and other related issues. There is always at least one trained first aider on each shift.

Referrals

The street van team can provide referral advice to people in need of assistance. We can often suggest the best place for clients to seek help.

Volunteering

Drug ARM WA is always looking for enthusiastic and dedicated volunteers to keep our Street Vans operating. If you have a passion to reach out to young people and could spare a few hours a fortnight or every four weeks we would love to have you on our team.
